

TPRI Printing

Administration of the TPRI will require a number of resources. These materials have been organized to allow you to print only what is needed to administer the TPRI for the grade level you teach.

In the grade level sections below, you will find a comprehensive list of materials necessary for administration of the TPRI. These grade level materials have been further organized into four categories: 1) Teacher's Guide, 2) Student stimulus materials, 3) Consumable materials, and 4) Intervention Activities Guide. Teachers may choose to create a four-tab binder organized according to these four categories in order to keep materials readily available for administration throughout the year. It is recommended that some items be printed on heavy paper or card stock for repeated use and durability.
